## HONG KONG MERCHANT SHIPPING INFORMATION NOTE

**United Nations Sanctions (Mali) Regulation 2018**

To : *Shipowners, Ship Managers and Masters*

***Summary***

The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) gazetted the United Nations Sanctions (Mali) Regulation 2018 (L.N. 268 of 2018) (the '2018 Regulation') on 21 December 2018. The '2018 Regulation' came into effect on the same date. It implements sanctions against Mali imposed by the Security Council of the United Nations Resolution 2432 (2018) dated 30 August 2018.

1. The United Nations Sanctions (Mali) Regulation 2018 (L.N. 268 of 2018) was gazetted and came into effect on 21 December 2018.
2. The '2018 Regulation' gives effect to certain decisions in Resolution 2432 (2018) as adopted by the Security Council of the United Nations on 30 August 2018 by providing for the prohibition against:
  - (a) making available to, or for the benefit of, certain persons or entities any funds or other financial assets or economic resources;
  - (b) dealing with funds or other financial assets or economic resources belonging to, or owned or controlled by, certain persons or entities; and
  - (c) entry into or transit through the HKSAR by certain persons.
3. The '2018 Regulation' will expire at midnight on 31 August 2019.

5. Owners, managers and masters of Hong Kong registered ships should abide by the regulations mentioned above.
