HONG KONG MERCHANT SHIPPING INFORMATION NOTE

United Nations Sanctions (Yemen) Regulation 2019 (Amendment) Regulation 2020

To : Shipowners, Ship Managers, Ship Operators and Masters

Summary

The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) gazetted the United Nations Sanctions (Yemen) Regulation 2019 (Amendment) Regulation 2020 (L.N. 81 of 2020) (the ‘Amendment Regulation’) on 15 May 2020. The Amendment Regulation, which came into effect on the same day, to give effect to certain decisions adopted by the Security Council of the United Nations under Resolution 2511 (2020) dated 25 February 2020.

1. The Amendment Regulation came into effect on 15 May 2020.

The main provisions of the Amendment Regulation relate to:

- (a) the prohibition on entry or transit of certain persons;
- (b) licences for the supply or carriage of arms or related materiel;
- (c) licences for the provision of assistance; and
- (d) licences for making available or dealing with economic assets.

3. Shipowners, ship managers, ship operators and masters of Hong Kong registered ships should abide by the regulations mentioned above.
